<u>Curriculum:</u> Our projects have started. The K-2nd grade children are busy making presentation boards and practicing singing for their upcoming visits to Kokoro and Kimochi Home. Our 3rd-5th grade children are excited to plan 3 different projects. One is designing their own obstacle courses. Another is to learn about the armors of the world and plan a competition by using their designs of armors. We also have a Video-making group that is designing characters and making a story to direct a Claymation movie. While they are engaged in their own projects, the children also want to plan for the upcoming Halloween party. They have lots of new ideas to make the party experience thrilling, but how are they going to execute all of these in a limited amount of time? We will see how the children can plan and manage their time!

<u>Fieldtrip</u>: As a way of showing respect and appreciation to the seniors in our community, the children will pay a visit to <u>Kokoro Assisted Living</u>, and the <u>Kimochi Home</u> on **Friday**, **September 15**th where they will sing a few songs in English and Japanese to entertain the seniors living in those facilities.
